# Freebie Friday Projects

## Ribbons & Lace Bracelet



### MATERIALS:

- (34) 4mm bicone crystals
- (1 color) bugle beads (any size)
- (2 colors) 15° seed beads
- Clasp of choice
- (2) 4-5mm 18ga open jump rings

### TOOLS & ACCESSORIES:

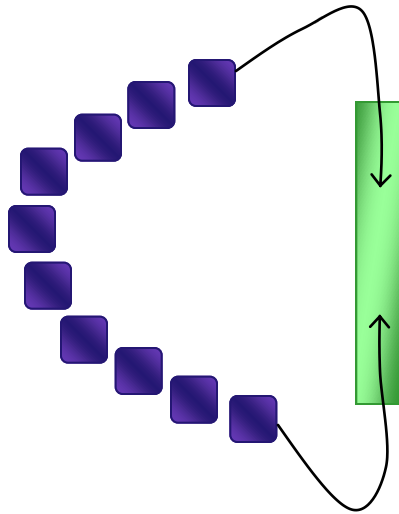
- Size 12 beading needle
- Fireline thread
- Small scissors or thread burner

#### Abbreviation Key

- 15sb**A** = 15° seed bead  
(color that bridges the bicones)
- 15sb**B** = 15° seed bead  
(color at bottom of bugle beads)
- 4mm = 4mm bicone crystal
- BB = bugle bead

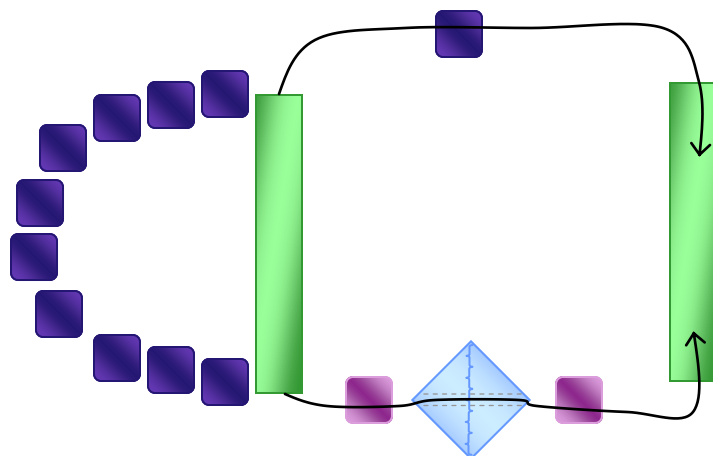
Step 1: Begin by cutting a 4ft piece of Fireline, and threading a needle on each end. Pick up (10) 15sb**B** and pull them to the middle of your thread between the two needles.

Pick up (1) BB and cross your needles going opposite directions through the BB.



Step 2: On one needle pick up (1) 15sb**B**. On the other needle pick up (1) 15sb**A**, (1) 4mm, and (1) 15sb**A**.

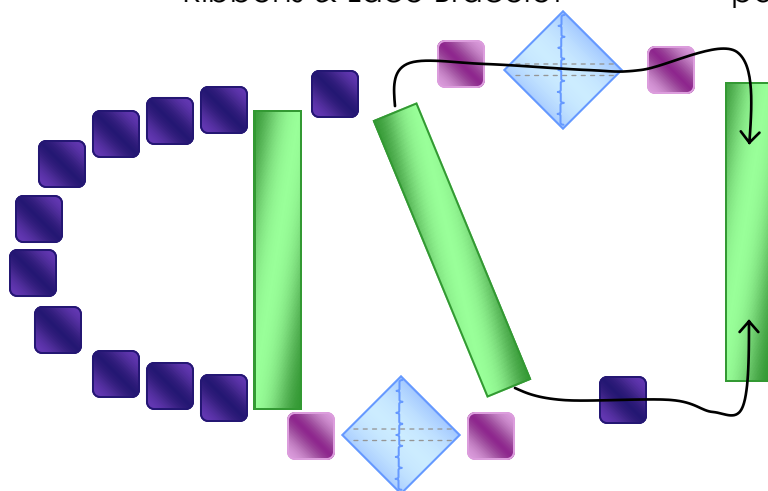
Pick up (1) BB and cross your needles going opposite directions through the BB.



Step 3: Now we will switch. On the side that had just the 15sb**B**, this time string (1)15sb**A**, (1)4mm, and (1)15sb**A**. On the other needle pick up (1)15sb**B**.

Pick up (1)BB and cross your needles going opposite directions through the BB.

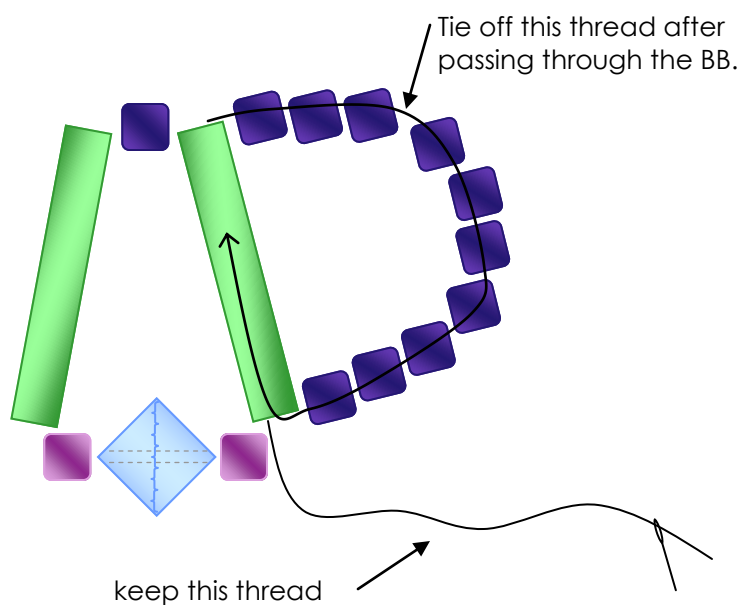
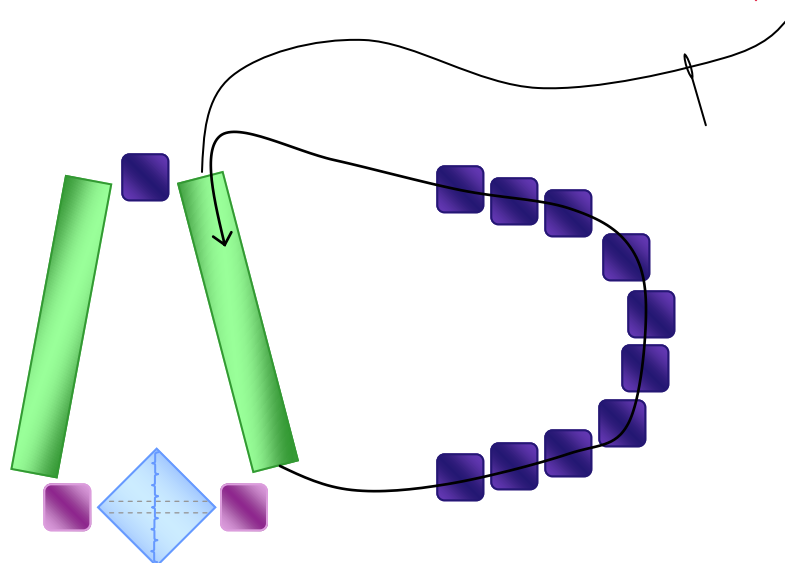
**REPEAT** steps 2 & 3 for the length of the bracelet.



On the far end of the bracelet (after crossing through your last BB), pick up (10)15sb**B** with one needle (it doesn't matter which one) and cross through the opposite side of the BB that your thread with the 15sb**B** is coming out of (forming a loop).

With your other needle, pass through all (10)15sb**B** and the BB to reinforce.

Tie off the thread that is on the opposite side of the bracelet from your first 4mm. We will only need one needle from here on out.



Step 4: Pass your needle through the first 15sbA next to the 4mm. Pick up (7) 15sbA and pass through the 15sbA and the BB on the far side of the 4mm.

Repeat Step 4 down the length of the bracelet. Once completed, you can add your clasp on the ends using an open jump ring. The heavier the jump ring, the more sturdy your clasp will be.
